

European Urban Youth Blast

14th March 2016, 10:00~13:30 at European House

The European Urban Youth Blast (EUYB) will be held on 14th March, prior to the Europe High Regional Meeting for Habitat III (Regional Meeting), which will take place on **16-18 March**. The EUYB will provide a regional space for "Europe and Others" youth to articulate urban priorities, solutions and commitments and to enhance youth engagement in the Habitat III "Habitat III" is shorthand for a major global summit, formally the United Nations Conference on Housing and Sustainable Urban Development, to be held in Quito, Ecuador, on 17-20 October 2016. The United has called **Nations** the conference. "reinvigorate" the global political commitment to the sustainable development of towns, cities and other human settlements.

The product of that reinvigoration, along with pledges and new obligations, is being referred to as the New Urban Agenda. That agenda will set a new global strategy around urbanization for the next two decades.

The UN Major Group for Children and Youth (UN MGCY) is the official space for children and youth to contribute to certain intergovernmental and policy processes at the United Nations. The UN MGCY is not an organization, but an open constituency, space and a platform for collaboration among youthled organizations, youth-serving organizations, child focused agencies, and individual young people. It's your space to maximise the voice of young people in the United Nations!
