Content of the project

The cycle of seminars examines the situation of human rights in Europe. It will be done from the perspective of young people. The seminar will be implemented as international youth worker mobility. 5. Training team

Through a competence-based approach, he aims to empower learners, emphasizing the crucial role of emotions, attitudes and diversity in holistic education. With a special focus on human rights, Daniele integrates these principles to foster a learning environment that not only enriches individuals but also contributes to our collective experience.

Laura Reiser, works as a coordinator for European youth policy projects for the Bavarian Youth Council. One of her fields of interest is how to face the right shift in Europe and its consequences for young people and youth work in Europe. She is an experienced facilitator for international youth leader mobilities.

6. Reimbursement of travel costs, participation fee

Travel costs will be reimbursed to the participants up to the captures given by the Erasmus+ - programme. (175,-€ for persons from Czech Republic). For that reason, we would need your travel tickets together with a payment request within two weeks after the activity.

The participation fee is 15,- € per person. The fee is needed to cover the costs, as we decided for a nice venue 😊). Participants will be sent an invoice in January 2024 and asked to make the transfer of the participation fee.
